Every person owning or keeping a dog in Coconino County must purchase a license when the dog is three months of age; or within 30 days of becoming owner or keeper; or within 30 days after moving to Coconino County.

Spay/Neuter Certificate required for sterilized fee;
 If your dog has been spayed or neutered, a certificate from a Veterinarian is required. You will be required to pay the unsterilized fee if you have no certificate.

Please attach your dog's rabies vaccination certificate to the license application.
 Incomplete and/or applications without required certificates (rabies vaccination and spay/neuter for sterilized fee) will be returned.

Animal Management will mail dog license(s) to you after processing your application. Please allow 3-5 weeks for processing.
